TIPS & BEST PRACTICES FOR USING YOUR KODAK PIXPRO ORBIT360 4K VR CAMERA

Now that you are ready to start using the ORBIT360 4K VR camera, we want to provide you with some quick and helpful tips that should ensure your 360° photos and videos turn out in the best way possible!



Getting Started with the KODAK PIXPRO ORBIT360 4K

Tip #1: Check your Camera's Firmware

Visit the support section on kodakpixpro.com and check the latest firmware version available. If your camera firmware needs updating, download and install the latest firmware as soon as possible to make your experience the best possible.

Tip #2: Shooting Positions Front/Back

The best way to hold your ORBIT360 4K is front to back. Position the front lens forward and use it as the central focus of your 360° video or photo.

Tip #3: Check your Shooting Modes

The ORBIT360 4K factory setting is in 360°/VR video mode at 24fps. Always make sure you have set your desired shooting mode before recording videos or taking photos.

Tip #4: Check Your Resolution

Make sure to check your camera's video resolution before shooting. The highest shooting resolution is 4K.

Example: 3840 x 1920, 15fps (Stitched)
3840 x 1920, 24fps (Lens A & B)
1920 x 960, 30fps (Stitched)

Tip #5: Remote Control

Your remote control options come in handy when you don't want to use your smart device or use the camera's buttons and interface.

Tip #6: Internal Stitching vs. External Stitching

As an additional benefit, the ORBIT360 4K camera's protective lens covers can be removed to avoid unwanted glare or other obstacles when shooting. Set your camera's recording mode to 'Dual Global' Mode (indicated with the "a" symbol), then manually adjust your stitch line using the complimentary PIXPRO 360 VR Suite software. For quick shots with no post stitching required, enter your settings menu and choose from the 3 resolution options without the "a" symbol and make sure both lens caps are on.

Tip #7: Use your PIXPRO iOS/ANDROID APP

The PIXPRO 360 Remote Viewer APP can be useful for previewing your shots or controlling the shooting modes and various settings on your ORBIT360 4K Camera. The APP will also allow you to upload 360° photos and videos on the go to FACEBOOK™ & 360° videos to YOUTUBE™
